

# St. John's Preschool Carnival 2012

## Event Overview

### Purpose

Provide a festive and fun environment for preschool families to celebrate community!

### Event Description

The carnival consists of several activities:

- Attractions (Louie Foxx-Magician, Balloons, Face Painting, Inflatables)
- Games
- Raffle Baskets
- Refreshments (Popcorn, Hot Dogs, Water, apples, Jamba Juice)

As families arrive, they will be able purchase admission tickets at the entrance and make their way into the Carnival where they may play games, enter the raffle, see and participate in the attractions and enjoy refreshments. Admission tickets are necessary to participate in the Carnival and can be purchased on-site the day of the event or pre-purchased at school beginning February 27th. Activities will be set up in different areas throughout the church and classrooms, including outside the church and on the playground in the covered area.

### Games

Classes will be assigned a game and parent volunteers will work 30-minute shifts to staff the game.

### Raffle Baskets

Each preschool class provides a basket filled with activities/items related to a specific theme chosen by the class teacher. Preschool families contribute items or cash to their class basket. While it is left to the room parents' discretion whether they ask their class for specific items, cash or a combination, we ask that the **requested** cash donation per family not exceed \$15 (\$15 is typical). Raffle baskets will be on display during Carnival week February 27-March 3. Families may enter the raffle to win any basket by purchasing raffle tickets during Carnival Week. February 27-March 3. Raffle winners will be announced towards the end of the Carnival.
