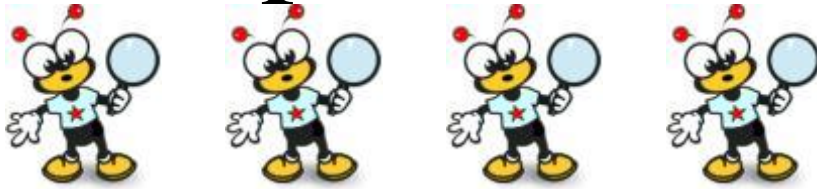


# September
